The tablature consists of two systems of four lines each, representing the strings A, E, C, and G. The first system shows measures 1-4, and the second system shows measures 5-8. Fret numbers are indicated by numbers on the lines, and chords are indicated by brackets below the lines.

System 1 (Measures 1-4):

- Measure 1: E string (1), C string (1), G string (1), A string (3)
- Measure 2: E string (1), C string (0), G string (3), A string (1)
- Measure 3: E string (1), C string (3), G string (1), A string (3)
- Measure 4: E string (1), C string (3), G string (0), A string (3)

System 2 (Measures 5-8):

- Measure 5: E string (1), C string (3), G string (1), A string (3)
- Measure 6: E string (3), C string (5), G string (3), A string (3)
- Measure 7: E string (3), C string (3), G string (3), A string (1)
- Measure 8: E string (1), C string (3), G string (2), A string (3)

The 4 lines represent the 4 strings of your ukulele. The top line is the string that is furthest from your eyes when you are playing the uke, ie. the A string. The bottom line is the string closest, or the G string.

The numbers represent the fret number you will be playing on the string where the number is placed.

In this example, the first 4 notes you would play are: the 1st fret of the E string (twice), then the 3rd fret of the C string, then back to the 1st fret of the E string!
