(Petty, Lynne)

The good news is that you will only need 3 chords for this entire tune! The (slightly) bad news is that 2 of them are probably new to you and to get the tune sounding good on the ukulele (in my opinion) you will need to use a capo.

I have found that the chord shapes used when you capo the 5th fret, tend to sound the most true to the original recording, but I will show you both ways.

To play the tune without a Capo, the chord progression is as follows:

F Fsus4 Fsus4 F Csus4

(This progression is used throughout the entire tune. You simply vary your strumming pattern and intensity as the tune progresses.)



As I said earlier, you can play the tune this way, but I've found that it sounds better when you Capo the 5th fret and play this progression:

C Csus4 Csus4 C Gsus4
